

NOTICE OF RESURFACING WORKS

AS PART OF OUR ANNUAL INVESTMENT INTO ROADS AND TRANSPORT THIS YEAR - CARRIAGEWAY REPAIRS WILL BE CARRIED OUT ON

U8297 CAUSEYHILL ROAD HEXHAM

WITHIN THE FOLLOWING DATES:

INFORMATION SIGNS WILL BE ERECTED IN ADVANCE OF THE ROAD CLOSURE WORKS AND ACCESS FOR RESIDENTS AND BUSINESSES WILL BE MAINTAINED AS FAR AS REASONABLY PRACTICABLE.

PLEASE REFRAIN FROM PARKING VEHICLES ON THE CARRIAGEWAY WHILST RESURFACING OPERATIONS ARE CARRIED OUT

What are you doing?

We will be carrying out a carriageway milling and resurfacing operation on the U8297 Causeyhill road, Hexham between Causey hill road / Collingwood Drive junction to Causey hill road / Yarridge Road junction, thus providing a structurally sound carriageway.

Access will be maintained at ALL TIMES to Causey hill holiday park via Yarridge road and the signed diversion route.

Who will be doing the works?

The contractor for the works will be Northumberland County Council.

How long will the work take?

Preparation works will commence 7th August under a road closure as the road is so narrow. The surfacing works are **planned** between 21st August to 25th August, **weather permitting**.

Will the works be disruptive?

The existing failing bituminous carriageway shall be milled out and replaced with a new structurally sound carriageway. The preparation and surfacing works shall be carried out under a road closure and authorised signed diversion route thus allowing works to be carried out as quickly and as safely as possible.

Every effort will be made to minimise the effects and duration of the works, however some disruption will be inevitable.
